- We have ATC on campus as a CO requirement, state law, and campus representation
- Current program overview of all transportation programs including Bird, Zipcar, MTS Passes, First Year Waivers, EV Stations, and outreach and education
- The transportation outreach program has grown over the last several months
 - PATS social media account is active and posting regularly
 - Tabling at first-year student orientations
 - Collaborating with other departments to expand outreach
- Red & Black shuttle is now Red & Black safe ride, the program has transitioned over to UPD and they will be providing ridership data
- PATS is in the contract process with Vanpool Enterprise and hope to have the program running sometime at the end of the semester or early next year
- New EV stations are being installed throughout campus. Lots P2A has a fast charger coming in, stations have been added to South Campus Plaza, and other chargers will go in as we continue to receive material/equipment
- Transportation Survey Results
- Clean Air Day is 10/4, parking will be tabling outside of the SDSU transit center. Giving out snacks, asking people to pledge, and promoting the other incentives SANDAG is offering
- Growing the F/S MTS Payroll Deduction program
 - We can offer the try transit program through SANDAG
 - Employees get to try transit for free for one month but they need to attend a SANDAG presentation first
 - We need to decide which month to offer this
 - The group is discussing maybe in November or February
 - The program will be offered in February and an orientation meeting will be held in January for faculty and staff
